Who Needs a Category 4 (pesticide seed treatment) License?

- 1. If you treat your own seed with a general use (over-the-counter non-restricted) pesticide and you plant it, you DO NOT need a pesticide license.
- 2. If you use a Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP) to treat your own seed and you plant it, you need a **Category 4 applicator license**.*
- 3. If you use a RUP to treat seed for someone other than yourself, you need both a Category 4 applicator license AND a Pesticide Business License.*
- 4. If you distribute treated seed from your treatment site to the farmer for planting, you need both a Category 4 applicator license AND a Pesticide Business License.
- 5. If you **ONLY** distribute treated seed to other retailers, **you DO NOT need a pesticide license**.

^{*} There is a two year requirement to keep records of a seed treatment application using RUPs.
