Subject: Commercial Feed Regulations Transition from 355 IAC 6 to IC 15-19-7

The Office of Indiana State Chemist (OISC) would like to inform commercial feed manufacturers, distributors, guarantors, and other stakeholders of an important legislative update affecting Indiana's commercial feed regulatory framework.

The Indiana General Assembly has transferred the requirements previously contained in **355 IAC 6 (Animal Foods)** into **Indiana Code 15-19-7 (Commercial Feed)**. This change relocates the regulatory provisions from the Indiana Administrative Code into state statute.

This legislative action is intended to streamline Indiana's commercial feed requirements while maintaining the regulatory framework governing the manufacture, distribution, sale, and labeling of commercial feed within the state. The requirements remain substantially the same; however, future references should be made to **IC 15-19-7** rather than **355 IAC 6**.

As a result of this change:

- References to **355 IAC 6** in guidance documents, forms, and communications should now be interpreted as **IC 15-19-7**.
- OISC will update publications, website content, forms, and other resources to reflect the new statutory citations.
- Commercial feed businesses should update any internal compliance documents, procedures, or reference materials that cite 355 IAC 6.

The Office of Indiana State Chemist remains committed to working with industry to ensure a smooth transition. If you have questions regarding this change or how it may affect your operations, please contact the Feed Program.
