Welcome to the 2020 Hemp Licensing application process. The 2020 Hemp License application is now available on our website <https://www.oisc.purdue.edu/hemp/index.html>. We strongly recommend completing the application using the free Adobe Acrobat Reader DC, which is available here: <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>. Opening the application in a web browser version of acrobat, does not allow you to complete and submit the application correctly.

Electronic signatures are required as part of this application, after each signature you will be prompted to save the document, that is normal. Please completely fill out the form, if your application is not complete for all areas that apply to your grower or handlers sites it will be denied and you will have to re-apply with the correct information.

Minimums are now in the administrative rules and must be followed for space and plant density, please see Section 52 of the Administrative Rules found on our website. If you complete the application with less than the minimum space, the application will be declined. When you check the box for outdoor or indoor, that will trigger our database for reading acres or square feet. Please put in numbers only in this area.

Please add all spots in grow sites and handling/processing sites where the crop will be grown, dried, processed under your control. We have provided enough space for 10 grow sites (each has to meet the minimum acres requirement) and for 20 drying, storing and processing sites. As part of the administrative rules no residence may be used as a grow or processing site. Outbuildings are allowed if they meet the minimum space requirements. These are hard and fast rules, there is no negotiation.

We expect processing of applications to take several weeks. There is a limit of 300 licenses for 2020.
