- WHAT:** An **Indiana Pesticide Clean Sweep Project** designed to collect and dispose of suspended, canceled, banned, unusable, opened, unopened or just unwanted pesticides (weed killers, insecticides, rodenticides, fungicides, miticides, etc.) is being sponsored by the Office of Indiana State Chemist (OISC). This disposal service is free of charge up to 250 pounds per participant. Over 250 pounds there will be a \$2.00 per pound charge. This is a great opportunity for you to legally dispose of unwanted products at little or no cost.
- WHO:** All public and private schools, golf courses, nurseries, farmers, ag dealers, cities, towns, municipalities and county units of government or others receiving this notice are eligible to participate.
- WHEN:** 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Local Time
- WHERE:** **August 16, 2016: Dubois County Fairgrounds in Huntingburg, IN**
August 17, 2016: Jackson County Fairgrounds in Brownstown, IN
August 18, 2016: Jefferson County Fairgrounds in Madison, IN
August 23, 2016: Newton County Fairgrounds in Kentland, IN
August 24, 2016: Allen County Fairgrounds in Fort Wayne, IN
August 25, 2016: Hendricks County Fairgrounds in Danville, IN
- HOW:** Complete the **Pesticide Clean Sweep Planning Form** to the best of your ability. Mail, fax or e-mail the completed form to Kevin Neal at the address listed at the top of this letterhead, 765-494-4331 (fax) or nealk@purdue.edu no later than **Monday, August 1, 2016**. Then bring your labeled, leak free and safe to transport containers to the collection site. **DO NOT** mix materials. In case of an emergency, you should bring with you a list of products you are carrying and a contact phone number.
- NOTE:** OISC reserves the right to cancel this Pesticide Clean Sweep Project if there is not adequate demand. Participants submitting the planning form by **August 1, 2016**, will be contacted immediately if cancellation is necessary.
