

2026 OISC Clean Sweep Pesticide Disposal Information Form

WHAT: An **OISC Clean Sweep Pesticide Disposal Program** designed to collect and dispose of suspended, canceled, banned, unusable, opened, unopened or just unwanted **pesticides** (herbicides, insecticides, rodenticides, fungicides, miticides, etc.) is being sponsored by the Office of Indiana State Chemist (OISC). This disposal service is free of charge up to 300 pounds per participant. Over 300 pounds there will be a \$3.00 per pound charge. This is a great opportunity for you to legally dispose of unwanted products at little or no cost.

WHO: All public and private schools, golf courses, nurseries, farmers, ag dealers, public, cities, towns, municipalities and county units of government or others receiving this notice are eligible to participate.
