

1. On July 25, 2011, I, Agent Joe Becovitz of the Office of Indiana State Chemist (OISC), performed an investigation at the Yeary residence in response to a claim of injury/damage to non-target trees and shrubs possibly resulting from exposure to the herbicide Imprelis. I observed the following during my on-site investigation:
 - a) The central leader on a single spruce tree appeared to be dead. I could not closely examine the injury nor could I sample the injured tissue as the tree was approximately 15' to 18' tall (see Figure 1).
2. I photographed the site documenting the symptoms I observed:


