PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Indiana General Assembly created the Indiana Pesticide Review Board

in 1972, through State Enrolled Act 599 to collect, analyze, and interpret information on matters relating to the use of pesticides in Indiana, and to

adopt rules to implement state and federal pesticide laws; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana Pesticide Review Board has been invaluable to the citizens of

Indiana to serve as an open and public forum for the development of both regulatory and non-regulatory solutions to a wide variety of

pesticide issues; and

WHEREAS, those pesticide issues have often been challenging and controversial, but

the Board has successfully addressed them in an overwhelmingly

consensus building manner; and

WHEREAS, since its inception the Board has established an effective and synergistic

working relationship with the public, regulated industries, the Purdue Cooperative Extension Service, the Office of Indiana State Chemist, and other state and federal agencies to further the protections provided by

law; and

WHEREAS, the Board has performed its intended function with distinction for over

forty-five years; and

WHEREAS, the Board will hold its 150th scheduled public meeting on June 1, 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim June 1st, 2017 as

Indiana Pesticide Review Board Day

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
