# 4. Dicamba Highly Volatile Herbicide determination review

Dave Scott reviewed 20-year OISC drift complaint investigation data, suggesting that for the 2023 application season the number of dicamba drift complaints appear to have finally been normalized to be no more prevalent than any other high volume use herbicide in Indiana. He shared that the dicamba complaints from the last three years involved less than 5% applications to any crop or site other than over-the-top (OTT) soybeans.

CES weed scientist Bill Johnson shared concerns about increased weed pressure in the western corn belt due to herbicide resistant water hemp. Indiana is just starting to see the HPPD herbicide resistance, and the June 20<sup>th</sup> application restriction complicates growers' ability to use dicamba in late planted corn, as we had in 2023.

MOTION: Recommend that OISC modify the terms of the application permit for Dicamba Highly Volatile Herbicide products, replacing the June 20<sup>th</sup> application cutoff date with a requirement that all Dicamba HVHs include a volatility reduction agent (VRA) in the application tank mix. The label directed June 12<sup>th</sup> application cutoff dates on the three dicamba OTT soybean products would remain unaffected by this action.;1<sup>st</sup> Mike Titus; 2<sup>nd</sup> Kevin Underwood

ACTION ITEM: approved; roll call vote #3; unanimous.

OISC also agreed to enter discussions with IDNR forestry staff to evaluate potential impacts of growth regulator herbicide use on nontarget trees, such as white and red oaks.
