Fiscal Impact Analysis on State and Local Government LSA Document #18-443

The proposed rule will have **no fiscal impact** on state and local government. This rule will simply restrict the distribution of seed or seed mixes containing any Amaranthus species seed not labeled as a flower or vegetable.

Likewise, state and local units of government are not in the business of serving as agricultural or vegetable seed vendors or dealers, and so will have no impacts on government.

The State Chemist of the State of Indiana is the agency charged with the administration and enforcement of the regulatory restrictions on the distribution of agricultural and vegetable seeds as is being proposed. Because the necessary infrastructure and regulatory programs for administering and enforcing the proposed restrictions are already well established, incorporating these products into that scheme will not require additional resources.
